A.P., India, hereinafter called the 'SETTLER' of this above said Trust.

WHEREAS THE SETTLER of the Trust are possessed of and otherwise well and sufficiently entitled to the sum of Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees one lakh only) hereinafter referred to as said property.

WHEREAS THE SETTLER of the Trust desire to irrevocably endowing the said founds upon trust for public, educational, and cultural, purposes, as hereinafter expressed and contained in this presents and in pursuance of such desire have already transferred paid and handed over the said property to the trustees mentioned below.

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Settler of the Trust that the Corpus of the Trust may be further augmented from time to time by flow of funds and other assets including moveable and immovable and any other kind by way of Gifts, or Donations, acquisitions, allotments, grant exchange or otherwise etc.


AND WHEREAS the TRUSTEES shall be

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITHNESES AS FOLLOWS:

- The name of the Trust shall be "NALLABOINA CHARITABLE EDUCATIONAL TRUST"
- 2. That the registered office of the Trust shall be situated at Sree Rama Krupa Plot No 25, Jaya Enclave, New Bowenpally, Secunderabad, Andhra Pradesh or at such other place or places as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time. Branch / administrative offices can be opened in any part of the country for the smooth functioning of the Trust.
- 3. Dr. Nallaboina Sudershan Acharya shall be the Life-Time Managing Trustee of the Trust. Mrs. Nallaboina Padmavathy shall automatically become Life-Time Managing Trustee after Dr. Nallaboina Sudershan Acharya either due to his resignation or after his life-time.
- The sum of Rs. 1,00,000 (Rupees One lakh Only) contributed to the funds of the said trust
 by the settler is held by the trustees for the purpose of the said trust.

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- 5. Such sums or assets as may be contributed, gifted, donated or bequeathed hereafter by the Settlor or by any person or persons, firm or company or by any State or Central Government or other authority to the said trust and shall include:
 - i. All interests or income arising out of the said sums and assets.
 - ii. Fee collected from students
 - All assets that may be purchased or acquired from out of the said funds or otherwise acquired for the said Trust.
 - iv. All investments and realizations there from out of the said funds and assets.
 - v. All sums and assets which have by any means become property of the Trust and
 - vi. The funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to Trustees / Beneficiaries any sum by way of profits, interest, dividends etc.

6. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

- 6.1 To promote and establish, run, continue and administer educational and vocational school or institution or college or deemed university and to run the same for educational or vocational purpose by name "Lead India Bharatha Ratnas", which will act as mother to a chain of quality educational schools / institutions / colleges / universities in every district / State to tailor to different socio-economic background schools as Centre of Excellence, teachers as Nation Builders and students as Global Leaders of 2020.
- 6.2 To establish and run a chain of educational institutions by name and in the style of "Lead India Bharatha Ratnas" throughout India in collaboration with other societies, trusts, non-governmental organizations by using methods, systems and procedures designed and developed by the Trust.
- 6.3 Shaping high vision to realize value based professional experts in creating world famous leaders, bureaucrats, industrialists, journalists and scientists carved a snitch for itself in training arena.
- 6.4 To develop moral and ethical political leaders, bureaucrats, industrialists, journalists and scientists
- 6.5 To create high visionaries with values, igniting potential skillful social and scientific vibrant cultural entrepreneurs to fuel national growth.

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- 6.6 To kindle self learning and infinite potential to supplement schools and curriculum with value based transformative educational model - Sudershana Chakra - Lead India "Aap Badho Desh Ko Badhao TM" full circle and help them to fulfill their vision.
- 6.7 To provide to the public and especially to economically backward students, all required extracurricular activities for the furtherance of their faculty to enable them to excel in their studies, fine arts, to learn foreign languages, sports including indoor and outdoor games and to educate them in all possible manner for the furtherance of their basic human values and perform works of charity for those in need throughout India and in case of necessity anywhere in the county through the Trust and in coordination with other NGO's
- To establish and run institutions providing general education and education in fine 6.8 arts, dance, music, instruments, information and computer technology, healthcare, environment, livelihood, bio-technology, HIV and other technologies either through class-room sessions, distance educational mode, on-line sessions, on-site sessions or by using any other advance technology.
- 6.9 To establish and run professional coaching centers to impart training for the civil services aspirants and other public service aspirants either through class-room sessions, distance educational mode, on-line sessions, on-site sessions or by using any other advance technology.
- 6.10 To takeover and administer educational institute or institution or colleges from time to time as decided by the trustees and to run the same to achieve the objects of the trust mentioned above

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- 6.11 To enter into an agreement or joint venture with any other institute, institution or college or university in India or in any other country to achieve the objects of the trust mentioned above.
- 6.12 To engage teachers, professors, instructors and experts in various subjects and disciplines and conduct to enable the trust to impart efficient coaching & teaching to pupils and students in various subjects & discipline vocational interests research work intellectual and other useful pursuits.
- 6.13 To conduct research on inculcation of values, potential skills etc. and work out projects and make collaborations etc.
- 6.14 To run community colleges / vocational / skill development programmes for employment / entrepreneurial / rural development of children, youth and women
- 6.15 To develop a healthy as well as excellent attitude towards the development of mental physical & moral uplift of the students and all those connected with the institution so as to make them good citizens

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- 6.16 To admit students for various discipline and subjects and for courses offered by the institution run by this trust and to offer scholarships to the deserving and/ or economically backward students.
- 6.17 To accept donations grants, presents and offerings, in cash or in kind form persons, association of persons, firms, companies, institutions, universities in India & abroad and to deal with the same for the purpose of achieving the objects of the trust mentioned above upon such terms and conditions as trustees may thinks fit and consistent with the objects of the trust
- 6.18 To charge moderate charges, tuition fees, coaching fees, or any other fees called otherwise to recoup the minimum basic administrative and other occupation expenses incurred in the upkeep and the maintenance of the institutions established, takeover or about to be established under this deed for this trust
- 6.19 To render social service activities, aimed at improving the living conditions and economic standard of the students, and their general welfare, in urban and the rural areas through the Trust and in co-ordination with other NGOs whenever required.
- 6.20 To construct, administer and oversee operations of a Temple / old age home / orphanage home etc.
- 6.21 To organize nitya-annadana and nama samkeerthan programmes and other programmes in similar nature;
- 6.22 Without prejudice to the generality of the aforementioned objects, the activities would be of purely charitable in nature and not motivated for profit

7. BENEFICIARIES OF THE TRUST

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The Trust is established for the benefit of citizens of India or Indian origin without discrimination of caste, religion, creed or sex.

NUMBER OF TRUSTEES, THEIR TERM AND POWER TO CO-OPT: 8.

- The Trust will be managed by a Board of Trustees consisting of not less than 2 (Two) trustees and not more than 10 (ten) trustees. The parties of the Second Part will be First Trustees and they shall automatically form the Board of Trustees
- The first Managing Trustee shall be the SETTLOR and he will hold office for his life 8.2 time. After the demise or relinquishment of office of the Managing Trustee, Mrs. Nallaboina Padmavathy shall ispo facto become the Life-time Managing Trustee. After the demise of Mrs. Nallaboina Padmavathy or relinquishment of her office as the Managing Trustee, Mr. Nallaboina Srenevas shall ispo facto become the Life-

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time Managing Trustee at his option or otherwise Mr. Nallaboina Srenevas shall have right to nominate any one of his sisters as Life-time Managing Trustee.

If he fails to do so, the remaining trustees from the family of Dr. Nalla Boina Sudershan Acharya shall elect as Managing Trustee out of his family.

- 8.3 The term of office of First Trustees shall be for their respective lives. The Board of Trustees shall have the power to increase the total number of Trustees upto the maximum number stated above and fix their term as per provisions contained herein. Dr. Nalla Boina Sudershan Acharya shall have right to co-opt, for a period of three years, such number of Honorary Trustees, who voluntarily extend their financial and / or intellectual support to the trust.
- Any Trustee, including the Managing Trustee may retire from the Trusteeship hereof by giving two calendar months notice in writing of his or her intention to do so, to the Board of Trustees and after the expiry of the period of notice, the Trustee giving the notice shall ipso facto cease to be a Trustee of these presents.
- 8.5 Any vacancy caused by death of any one of the First Trustees, or any vacancy caused by the resignation of any of the Trustees, may be filled up by co-option by the Board of Trustees.
- 8.6 The Trustees who are not First Managing Trustee or First Trustees shall hold office for a period of two-years from their date of appointment by the Trustees. At the end of this one year period, the Board of Trustees may reappoint them for subsequent term or appoint other persons as Trustees in such a manner that the total number of Trustees does not exceed the approved maximum number of Trustees.
- 8.7 The Managing Trustee shall have the power to remove a Trustee suffering from mental disability or if he is accused of misfeasance of trust funds or property or misconduct, after satisfying himself on enquiry and such action of the Managing Trustee shall be final.
- 8.8 The proceedings of the Board of Trustees shall not in any way be invalidated due to any post or posts remaining vacant. During the time when a vacancy is yet to be filled up, the remaining Trustees shall act as "Full Board", subject to the presence of Quorum in the meetings. Any vacancy in the Board of Trustees or illegality in the appointment of Trustees or their proceedings shall not invalidate any prior act or decision of the Board.

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TRUST ADMINISTRATION AND POWER TO THE BOARD:

The Board of Trustees shall have following powers:

- To administer the Trust, its properties and affairs and do all the things which will fulfill the performance of the objects for which the Trust is established and for this purpose the Board can apply the whole or any part of the Trust property towards the payment of the expenses of the Trust.
- 9.2 The income and the properties of the Trust will be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of it will be utilized for payment to the Settler, or Trustees or their relatives by way of salary, allowances, profit, interest, dividend etc.
- To open one or more bank accounts and operate the same or provide for operation of the said accounts by any two among them authorized on their behalf.
- 94 To invest the Trust funds in the manner not prohibited by any provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- To buy, sell, mortgage, grant, lease, hire or otherwise alienate all or any of the 9.5. properties of the Trust in its discretion for adequate consideration, so however any sale or alienation of immovable properties of the trust can be done only after obtaining the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.
- 96 To execute power of attorney or powers of attorney to any person for the purpose of executing, administering or managing the whole or any part of the Trust for the purpose of all or some among the objects of the Trust.
- 9.7. To borrow money with or without security and to repay the same.
- 9.8 To receive, collect and enforce recovery of all monies due or payable to the Trust and grant receipts and discharges therefore.
- 9.9. To settle, compromise or compound any disputes or refer the same to arbitration or litigation.
- 9.10. To receive voluntary contributions from any person or persons from India or outside, after complying with the statutory formalities, by way of donation, gifts or in any other manner and to hold the same upon Trust for the objects set forth herein.

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- 9.11. To appoint, suspend, dismiss or otherwise deal with the staff required for the administration of the Trust, to frame rules relating to their salaries and other benefits and generally to exercise all powers ancillary and incidental to effectively carry out the objects of the Trust.
- 9.12. The Board shall have power to make and rescind rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust.
- 9.13. No Trustee shall commit any act or breach of Trust of the Trust fund or property or cause any loss to the Trust property or commit fraud in the administration of the Trust fund / property.
- 9.14. The Trustees shall hold honorary office and shall not be entitled to any Salary, allowances or perquisites, except for the reimbursement of actual expenses incurred in connection with attending to the Trust matters.
- 9.15. The Board of Trustees will follow the instructions given by any donor who makes substantial contribution towards furtherance of the objects of the Trust, so long as such instructions are not detrimental to the attainment of the objects of the Trust and are in conformity with the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961.
- 9.16. For the management and administration of the Trust, the Trustees shall elect one amongst themselves for each of the offices of Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The term of office for Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be for a period of one year from their date of appointment and they may be reelected for further terms. No Trustee including the Managing Trustee shall hold more than one of the above offices at the same time. The persons holding these offices of Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be under the administrative guidance and supervision of the Managing Trustee and will report to him directly.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND POWERS

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
The Roles, Responsibilities and powers of all these officers is defined below. In addition to these, the Managing Trustee may grant additional roles, responsibilities and powers to any of the Trustees.

10.1 MANAGING TRUSTEE:

In addition to discharging normal duties of a trustee, the Managing Trustee shall preside over meeting of the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustee is authorized to sign all documents, including bank documents, acknowledgements for the contributions received, and agreements with individuals, Government Institutions and other organizations, on behalf of the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustee shall have all the residuary powers, not explicitly assigned to any of the other officers in these presents.

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The Managing Trustee is authorized to sign along with the Treasurer bank cheques, deposit release vouchers etc. The Managing Trustee is empowered to remove any Trustee from the Trust and its offices, if he/she finds that his/her activities are not congenial to the activities of the Trust.

The Managing Trustee is responsible for ensuring that the Trust pursues its Objects and for maintaining the dignity of the Trust organization and shall use his/her influence to promote the activities of the Trust.

10.2 VICE PRESIDENT:

The Vice President shall discharge the duties of the Managing Trustee, in the absence of the Managing Trustee of the Trust and shall have the power and authority delegated and assigned to him/her by the Managing Trustee.

10.3 SECRETARY:

The Secretary shall maintain the records of the organization prepare and circulate agenda and minutes of Board of Trustee meeting for the approval of the Managing Trustee.

The Secretary shall be also responsible for the day to day administration activities of the Trust. The Secretary shall deal with correspondence received by the Trust, send replies in consultation with the Managing Trustee, Vice President and/or the Treasurer where necessary. He/she is responsible for the safe custody of all the properties and records of the Trust. The Secretary shall represent the Trust in all legal matters, sign the papers related to legal cases, attend to courts or represent the Trust in Government offices.

10.4 TREASURER:

The Treasurer will prepare Annual Budget, monthly and yearly expenditure statements get the expenditure audited by auditor duly appointed by the Board of Trustees and place them before the Board of Trustees for approval. The Treasurer is responsible to maintain cash book and prepare vouchers for the payments made, receive contributions, sign acknowledgements for the amounts or articles received by the Trust and prepare monthly and yearly statements of revenue and expenditure, as well as, the register of assets of the Trust and place them before the Board of Trustees for their approval.

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The Treasurer is authorized to sign bank cheques, application for drafts and payment instructions jointly with the Managing Trustee and draw money from the bank, upto the limits defined by the Board of Trustees in their meetings. The Treasurer is responsible for safe custody of cash, bonds, securities etc. of the Trust.

11. MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

The Board of Trustees should meet at least once in every calendar quarter and may meet more often when required.

- 11.1 The meeting of Board of Trustees shall be convened by the Managing Trustee and he shall preside over the meetings. In his absence, the Managing Trustee may authorize the Vice President to be the Chairman of such meetings. In the event the Managing Trustee or Vice President are not able to attend the meeting already convened, any of the Trustees present in the meeting may elect one amongst themselves to be the Chairman of the meeting.
- 11.2 One third of the Board of Trustees or a minimum of two trustees, whichever is higher, shall constitute the QUORUM for the Board of Trustee meetings.
- 11.3 All decisions shall be carried out by the majority decision of the Board but in the event of equality of votes, the Chairman presiding over the meeting shall have a casting vote.
- 11.4 Any resolution in writing signed by all the Trustees by circulation shall have equal force as though it has been passed at a meeting of the Board of Trustees.
- 11.5 The meeting of the Board shall be conveyed after giving at least a week's notice unless all the Trustees agree to accept a shorter notice.
 - 11.6 The Board of Trustees may invite other persons interested in the objects and functioning of the Trust to attend the meetings of the Board, but they shall not be entitled vote in the meetings of the Board.

12. BANK ACCOUNT:

The Managing Trustee and the Treasurer shall jointly operate Bank Accounts on behalf of the Trust. In their absence, any of the Trustees may be authorized by the Managing Trustee, by a resolution, to operate the bank accounts. One or more Bank Accounts may be opened in any Bank and or Banks in the name of the Trust.

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INVESTMENT OF TRUST FUNDS:

- The Board of Trustees shall have the power to invest the funds, assets and properties of the Trust at their discretion in accordance with the provisions of the
- 13.2 The Board shall also determine from time to time, the amount it shall spend on the

ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

- The financial year of the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March of the following year, unless otherwise decided by the Board of Trustees.
- 14.2 The Board of Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of the Trust.
- The accounts of the Trust shall be annually audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Board of Trustees and the audited statement of account shall be placed before the Board for its approval within six months of the close of the financial

15. RULES & REGULATIONS:

- The Board of Trustees shall frame rules and regulations of the trust for administration
- The rules and regulations can be amefided by a majority of vote of Board of

AMENDMENTS:

- While this Trust shall be irrevocable, the Board of Trustees may amend any of the clauses except those relating to objects of the Trust, the First Managing Trustee and First Trustees, at a duly convened meeting of the Board with at least 2 weeks' notice, and by a resolution passed by alleast three-fourths majority of the Board of Trustees present and voting. The amendments to the Trust deed can only be passed by a resolution of the Board of Trustees in an actual meeting and not by circulation.
- 16.2 If any alteration or amendment is necessary, the same shall be affected through supplementary deed/deeds with the previous approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax, if required and these shall be read together with the main Trust deed.

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17. INDEMNITY:

The Board of Trustees shall be indemnified for any act done by them in good faith in the course of the administration of the Trust.

18. SETTLOR AND THEIR RELATIVES:

Notwithstanding the powers vested with the Trustees under the proceeding clause, no part of the income of the Trust shall benefit directly or indirectly the trustees and no part of the benefit of:

- (a) SETTLOR, Managing Trustee, Trustees or any person who makes a substantial contribution to the Trust or of any relative of the SETTLOR, Managing Trustee, Trustees or the person who makes a substantial contribution.
- (b) Any "related concern" in which any of the above persons has substantial interest.
- (c) For the purpose of this clause, the word "relative" and the phrases "related concern", "substantial interest" and "substantial contribution" shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

19. APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT:

The provisions of the Indian Trust Act 1882 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents.

20. APPLICATION OF INCOME TAX ACT:

All clauses herein are intended to secure exemption from Income Tax on the income of contributions and donations to the Trust and any clause or portion of this Deed of Trust which is inconsistent with or repugnant to the sections of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended, substituted or modified from time to time, shall be deemed to be deleted or modified with effect from the date on which the sections to which the clause or part of a clause is repugnant or inconsistent comes into force.

21. THIS TRUST IS DECLARED IRREVOCABLE:

This trust is declared irrevocable.

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22. DISSOLUTION:

In the event of dissolution of the Trust, the entire Trust funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust. The assets left if any, shall be disbursed to other Trusts or Associations having similar objectives after obtaining previous approval of Commissioner of Income-tax and in no event it shall be distributed in any manner, to any of the Board of Trustees or their relatives or related concerns.
